





Since the inception of the execution of sewerage works periodical meetings are being held regularly in Jacobabad to monitor all field activities by TPM-TCI, comply all observation by RCC Consultants and to provide required administrative support by PSU-MSDP. At the start, field coordination was held on a weekly basis but now it is held on a fortnightly basis. The core objective of these meetings is to implement the work plan on the ground in such a way that supervision as well as monitoring can be done properly by RCC Consultants & TPM-TCI respectively.






13 SITE VISIT
